AN ACT DESIGNATING THE ELEPHANT AS THE OFFICIAL MAMMAL OF THE COMMONWEALTH.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

Chapter 2 of the General Laws is hereby amended by adding the following section:-
Section 58. The elephant shall be the official land mammal of the commonwealth.
