AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE ANNUAL OBSERVANCE OF GREYHOUND ADOPTION MONTH

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

SECTION 1. Chapter 6 of the General Laws is hereby amended by inserting after section 15 FFFFF the following section:- SECTION 15 GGGGG. The governor shall annually issue a proclamation setting apart the month of June as Greyhound Adoption Month in recognition of what great pets retired racing greyhounds make and recommending the day be observed in an appropriate manner by the people.
